I am a veteran of Korea defense service and I am writing to you to request your help in obtaining the Republic of Korea Service Medal. This recognition award was presented by the R.O.K. during the 1970's (see enclosure) but was stopped by the U.S. Joint Chiefs of Staff after a two year period of issue. This was an insult to the R.O.K. and to defense veterans. The Korea Defense Veterans of America, a veteran's organization, United Kingdom Korea defense veterans and I request the R.O.K. to re award this medal and we need your support. Because your corporation has benefited from our service, we hope you will assist us.

The outstanding growth and economic stability enjoyed by the Republic of Korea and your corporation have been realized in large part due to the armed forces from the United Nations Command that have served in defense of South Korea since the cease-fire agreement of 1953.
